

Educational Support and Curriculum Adaptations


For Erasmus Students


If you need support or curriculum adaptations during your stay at UPCT, follow these steps:

Step 1: Contact SAED

Start the process by emailing the Service for Students with Disabilities and/or Special Educational Needs (SAED):

 saed@upct.es

 Indicate that you would like to request curriculum adaptations.

 After your email, you will be invited to a meeting with the **Diversity and Inclusion Support Unit**.

Step 2: Personal Assessment

Your case will be reviewed by an **external licensed psychologist**.

- You will be contacted by email or phone
 - A personal interview will be arranged
 - Your individual needs will be assessed

Documents to Provide

(If available)

- Disability certificate
 - Medical or specialist reports
 - Psychological reports
 - Any other relevant supporting documents
-

Step 3: Support Plan

After the assessment:

- A personalised report will be prepared
 - It will include recommended support measures or adaptations
 - The report will be officially signed and validated
-

Step 4: Communication with Lecturers

- Your lecturers will receive the report
 - Only relevant information will be shared
 - Your **privacy and confidentiality are guaranteed**
-

Important Information

- The report is valid for **one academic year only**
 - You must **apply again each year** if you still need support
